  - Cadmium yellow light or Hansa yellow
  - Yellow ochre
  - Cadmium red light or Naphthol red
  - Cadmium red deep
  - Alizarin crimson
  - Venetian red
  - Cerulean blue
  - Ultramarine blue
  - Burnt Sienna or Transparent Oxide red (Rembrandt brand)
  - Dioxazine purple
  - Ivory black ( optional)
- Brushes:**
- Natural hog bristle (Flats, brights, or filberts - your choice)  
Sizes # 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16
  - Round or flat Sable ( or good synthetic type) Size # 1 or 2
- Other:**
- Mineral spirits - odorless only ( no turpentine please )
  - Oil painting medium, your choice - I mix my own ( 25% linseed oil and 75% odorless mineral spirits )
  - Canvasses: Suggested sizes - 16" x 20", 18" x 24", or 22" x 28"
  - Soft cloth
  - Paper towels
  - Plastic bags ( supermarket type for used paper towels etc.)
  - Charcoal ( small vine)
  - Pallet ( the larger the better - Put out lots of paint w/ ample room to mix.)

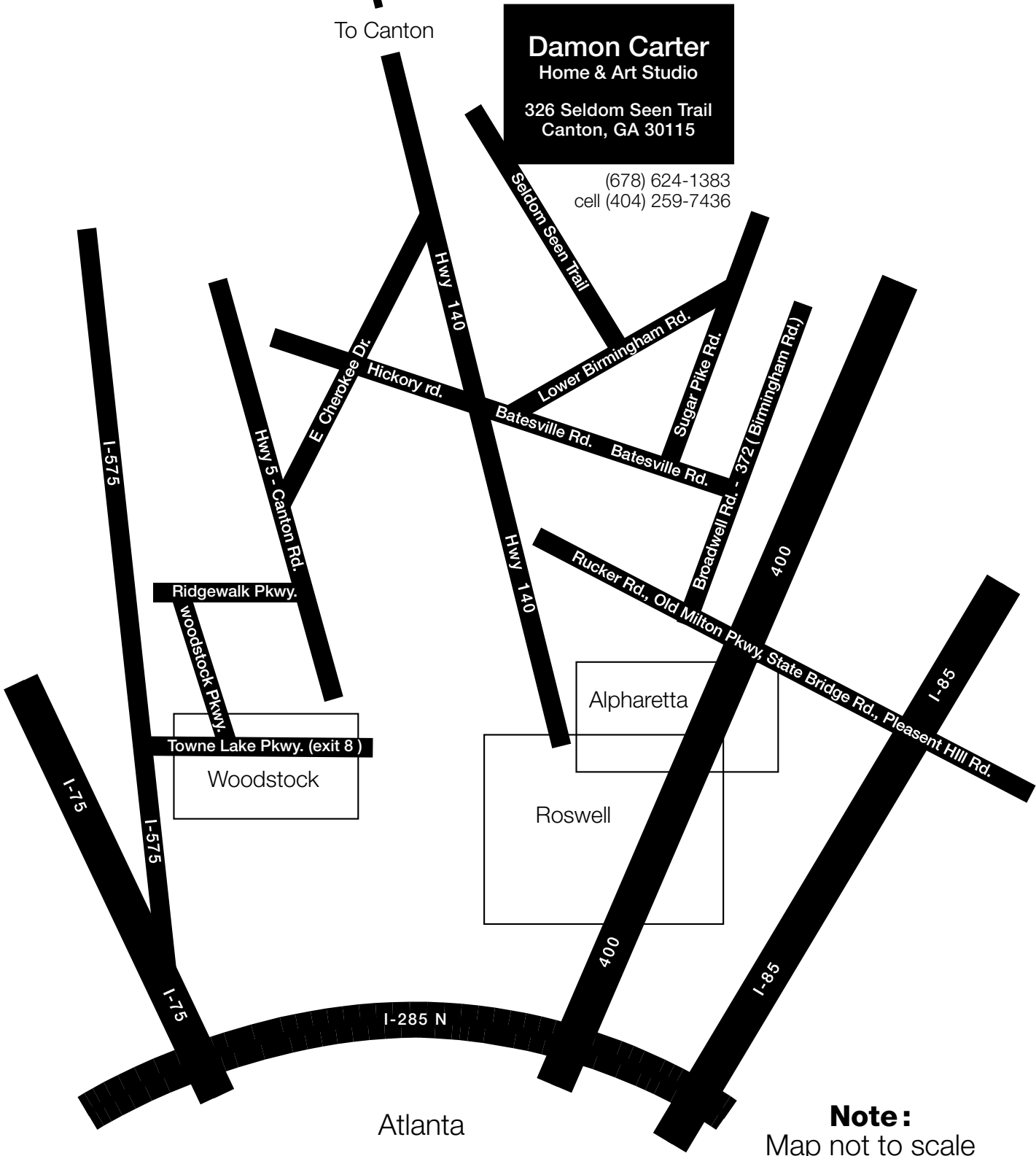

## Directions from I-75 N and I-575

- Take I-75 N, exit right onto I-575
- Go 8 miles to Towne Lake Pkwy. (exit 8)
- Go right on Towne Lake, go 1/10 mile and
- Go left on Woodstock Pkwy.
- Go 1 & 7/10 miles, turn right on Ridgewalk Pkwy.
- Go 7/10 mile, turn left on Hwy 5, Canton Rd.
- Go 1 & 3/10 miles, turn right on E. Cherokee Dr.
- Go 5 & 2/10 miles, turn right on Hickory Rd.
- Go straight through the next traffic light, Hickory Rd. becomes Batesville Rd. Go 1 mile,
- Turn left on Lower Birmingham Rd.
- Go 8/10 mile, turn left on Seldom Seen Trail
- Go 3/10 mile to 326 Seldom Seen Trail. Number is on the mailbox on the right.

## Directions from Roswell VIA Hwy 140

- From Alpharetta St. (Hwy 9, Main St.) in Roswell ( If you are going North)
- Turn left on Mansell Rd. Go 1 block and
- Turn right on hwy 140. ( You will be going North, see map on reverse side ) Go 10 miles,
- Turn right at Hickory Rd sign ( It becomes Batesville Rd.) Go 1/2 mile,
- Turn left on Lower Birmingham Rd. Go 8/10 mile,
- Turn left on Seldom Seen Trail. Go 3/10 mile to 326 Seldom Seen Trail. Number is on the mail box on the right.

## Directions from I-85 N and 400

- Take I-85 N to Pleasant Hill Rd. exit ( exit 10)
- Go left on Pleasant Hill Rd, ( see map on reverse side) It will become State Bridge Rd then it becomes Old Milton Pkwy. ( If you had taken 400 N instead of I-85 this is where you would exit - Old Milton Pkwy.) ( see map on reverse side) From I-85 to 400 is 11 miles. From this point the directions are the same for both exits. You are now on Old Milton Pkwy, it will change names again to Rucker Rd. From 400 you will travel 4 miles then,
- Turn right on Broadwell Rd. It will become 372 ( Birmingham Rd.)
- Go 3.4 miles, turn left on Batesville Rd.
- Go 3 miles to a 4-way stop sign,
- Turn right on Sugar Pike Rd. Go 1.4 miles to another 4-way stop,
- Turn left on Lower Birmingham Rd. Go 7/10 mile,
- Turn right on Seldom Seen Trail. Go 3/10 mile to 326 Seldom Seen Trail. Number is on the mail box on your right.
